Overview

Explore two of Botswana's premier game viewing destinations on this 5 day fully serviced mobile camping safari. On this incredible safari adventure, you'll spend 2 nights in Moremi Game Reserve, located on the eastern edge of the Okavango Delta and containing all the magnificence of the Delta's wildlife and birdlife whilst being a little easier to access. This truly magnificent landscape and unique ecosystem attracts animals from kilometres around and creates one of Africa's greatest wildlife concentrations. This will be followed by 2 nights in the Khwai Concession, lying to the east, nestled between Moremi and Chobe - a magical area which is a magnet for animal and bird lovers.

Driven in your specialized custom-built safari vehicle by your professional safari guide, this private safari offers you the flexibility to travel at your own pace, exactly the way you like it. Relax and indulge yourself in the diverse landscapes ranging from drier inland areas to the permanent water sources of the Delta. Sit back, unwind and let us plan everything for you.

Detailed Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Maun – Transfer to Moremi Game Reserve

Arrive at Maun Airport where you'll be met by your safari guide. Travelling north-east by road from Maun, you will be transferred to Moremi Game Reserve - Africa's finest game viewing

region. Eventually, after having travelled 99 kilometres from Maun, you'll reach the southern entrance gate of the Moremi Game Reserve.

Upon reaching your private designated campsite, everything will be set up and ready for you - all camping equipment for the trip duration including spacious dome tents with stretcher beds, mattresses, bed linen and en-suite bush ablutions, including a mobile kitchen and dining area. This safari is a non-participation tour where your safari team will carry out all the necessary chores to keep the safari running smoothly. Time to have lunch and relax before going on an afternoon game drive, searching for the wide variety of wildlife and birds that this area is renowned for, while absorbing the sounds and beauty of this region.

You will arrive back at camp just before dark to a roaring fire to welcome you back after an afternoon out searching for wildlife with your guide.



Day 2: Explore Moremi Game Reserve

Depart early on a game drive which will take you to Xini and Black Pools. These areas are in the south western part of Moremi. With seasonal and permanent swamp landscape, these two areas are home to all major animal species including elephant, hippo, buffalo, wildebeest, impala, kudu, tsessebe, giraffe, waterbuck, red lechwe, zebra, lion, leopard, cheetah, spotted hyena, wild

dog, and more than 500 bird species - including African fish eagle, African skimmer, southern carmine bee-eater, crested crane, sacred ibis, green-winged pytilia, wattled crane, lesser jacana, and many more.

Your morning game drive will end mid-morning and brunch will be served after you get back to camp. Brunch is followed by a few hours of leisure in camp. The direction of the afternoon game drive is often determined by what you saw in the morning. Sightings worth returning to are visited again.

After an adventurous day and a sundowner, a leisurely game drive to your camp will give you great opportunities for amazing views of the sun setting over this area, which combines mopane woodland and acacia forests, floodplains and lagoons.



Day 3: Transfer - Moremi Game Reserve to Khwai Concession

Depart early on a game drive, after a light breakfast. From Moremi Game Reserve drive through to Khwai area, a picturesque destination that offers endless photographic opportunities for the avid nature lover. The mix of habitats allows endless exploration opportunities, from grassy plains and wetlands to mopane woodlands and open savannahs.

Upon reaching your private designated campsite, everything will be set up and ready for you. Time to have lunch and relax before going on an afternoon game drive. From elephants and giraffes to wild dogs and big cats, you can get up close with wildlife and a variety of bird species which inhabit the area, so this area is also sure to provide an unforgettable experience for those passionate bird watchers.



Day 4: Khwai Concession Exploration

Early morning and afternoon game drives through the area will give you the best opportunity to witness this remote location renowned for offering excellent wildlife sightings. Today you'll have chances to spot elephant, hippo, crocodile, giraffe, zebra, buffalo, impala, kudu, lion, leopard, spotted hyena and wild dog.

An afternoon mokoro (dug-out canoe) excursion will take you along a tributary of the Khwai River to view game from another perspective and to experience this tranquil mode of transport. You'll enjoy the stunning views from this unique perspective and spot various aquatic wildlife, including African skimmers, African jacana, and many more. You will also have the opportunity to venture out on a night drive, focusing on the wildlife that uses darkness to its best advantage.

The Khwai Concession belongs to the local community, under the governance of Khwai Development Trust. The trust ensures the proceeds from the concession benefit the local community of Khwai village.



Day 5: Transfer - Khwai Concession to Maun

Depart early on a game drive. This is your last opportunity to see the more elusive animals not yet spotted over the past 2 days, as you continue on to Maun. Our safari comes to an end as we arrive in Maun to connect with homeward flights, or to continue with onward extensions.

- Exclusive camping in private campsites within the national parks and game reserves.
- All transfers and activities as per the itinerary.
- All meals and tea / coffees.
